## West End Master Plan Public Meeting

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### History

In the spring of 2006, following Hurricane Katrina, the Regional Planning Commission worked with the community to develop a vision for the redevelopment of the West End area with a “smart growth” grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Not long after this community engagement, RPC initiated a market analysis and feasibility study based on the community vision. Both the *West End Land Use and Site Plan Analysis* and the *Market Analysis and Absorption Study* are available online at [www.norpc.org/sub-area\\_studies.html](http://www.norpc.org/sub-area_studies.html). Concurrently, as the RPC developed the market analysis and absorption study, the Army Corps of Engineers announced its intentions to locate a permanent pump station in the West End vicinity. In 2010 the New Orleans Municipal Yacht Harbor Mgmt Corp commissioned Cashio Cochran to prepare an initial draft master plan rendering (<http://nomunicipalharbor.com>) that reflected the 2006 public feedback and the identified location of the permanent pump station.

### Now

You are invited to participate in a Public Meeting to move planning forward for West End to the next level. On January 31, 2012, the Regional Planning Commission in partnership with the New Orleans Municipal Yacht Harbor Management Corporation, the New Orleans City Planning Commission, Jefferson Parish Planning, and the Friends of West End, Inc. will hold a Public Meeting to discuss the creation of a refined master plan for the redevelopment of the West End area.
